Reminder as to Member Court Use / Booking We ask that members take the time to read and follow the <u>Rules for Court Use / Booking</u> which can be found on our website together with a host of information relating to the Club, this also acts as our Club Handbook e.g. *Members playing with other members is Free, if playing with a Non Member there is a £5 Guest fee payable, ALL participants should be booked in at time of court booking.*

There is a Pay & Play System available for Non Members @ £10 per court per hour

Clubhouse New Access Code lock has been installed on the Clubhouse door doing away with the old key system, at present individual codes are available to Full category members. When using, code holders are responsible for the safety and security of the clubhouse, all members are asked to make sure the door is not left open if a member is not in the clubhouse, (we have had instances where random people have entered, unfortunately this is the drawback of being adjacent to a public footpath). There may be times at events or coaching when a one off timed code is available your organiser will advice if so.
