Club Championship Rules for 2018

All Senior matches will consist of the best of 3 tie-break sets.

The player(s) at the top of the draw will contact opponents to arrange suitable date for the tie. The Tournament Committee would appreciate it if players could arrange ties as early as possible as weather can be unpredictable and it may be necessary to re-arrange.

Any player losing in the first round will automatically be entered into Consolation Competition (number of entrants permitting). This will be a knock out competition with the final played on Finals' Day.

Competitors must be available to play on Finals' Day. If any player becomes no longer available to play on Finals' Day they must withdraw from the competition and inform the Organising Committee.

If a player is unable to play a tie by the set date due to bad weather, injury or any other unavoidable reason, they can request a short extension from the organising committee. The Committee's decision will be final.

The Organising Committee reserves the right to alter the playing schedule.
