

Club Championship Rules for 2024

- All Senior matches will consist of the best of 3 tie- break sets or if agreed 3rd set 10 point championship tie break.
- The player(s) at the top of the draw will contact opponents to arrange suitable date for the tie. The tournament committee would appreciate it if players could arrange ties as early as possible as weather can be unpredictable and it may be necessary to re-arrange.
- Ladies doubles, Men's singles and Mixed Doubles– first and second round losers will enter the Consolation Cup.
- Men's doubles – first round losers will enter the Consolation Cup.
- There will be no Ladies Consolation Cup.
- The finals of Consolation Competitions will also take place on Finals Day.
- Competitors must be available to play on Finals Day. If any player becomes no longer available to play on Finals Day they must withdraw from the competition and inform the organising committee.
- If a player is unable to play a tie by a set date due to bad weather, injury or any other unavoidable reason, they can request a short extension from the organising committee. The committee's decision will be final.
- The organising committee reserves the right to alter the playing schedule.

Ladies Singles

- Ladies singles- group stage. Each player plays each other once best of three sets. The top two qualify for the final. If there is a tie on points it will be decided on the difference between sets won and lost, then head to head.
- Points system
2-0 win = 3 points to winner
2-1 = 2 points to winner and 1 to loser
