

What does your WTC membership pay for?

WTC is a not-for-profit, volunteer run club accredited by the LTA. The WTC courts and clubhouse are owned by Winterbourne Parish Council (WPC), who charge the tennis club an annual occupation fee for use of the facilities. WTC are therefore responsible for the day-to-day costs of running the clubhouse, maintaining the court surface and energy costs. Any major refurbishment items such as court resurfacing, fencing etc are the responsibility of WPC but are subject to availability of funding in the parish council budget.

WTC's primary source of income is from annual membership fees which cover the following costs:

- LTA annual venue registration fees
- Winterbourne Parish Council occupation fees
- Electricity charges (incl. floodlights)
- Insurance
- Coaching equipment and balls
- League entry fees
- Grounds maintenance
- Maintenance equipment and supplies
- Clubhouse supplies
- Clubhouse cleaning and maintenance
- Sinking fund for future improvements
- (WTC's coaches are self-employed and are not paid by the club)
