## County call up for James



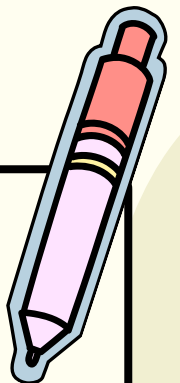
