



Court Etiquette

- Have fun. The entire objective of playing tennis, aside from being good aerobic exercise, is to have fun! It's a game and should be enjoyed as such.
- Everyone must wear appropriate tennis shoes to enter the courts. No one may enter the court unless wearing tennis non-marking shoes with rubber soles.
- When entering and leaving the courts, please always observe basic manners: wait for the end of a point before walking across the back of the centre court. Always close the gate behind you.
- All balls should be collected at the end of play and, if not yours, returned to the clubhouse.
- Please take all rubbish with you when exiting the courts. Any litter should be placed in the bins provided.
- No drinks on court other than water. Other drinks to be kept in or around the clubhouse.
- No chewing gum on court.
- Please think about members playing on the courts and endeavour to keep noise within suitable bounds.
- No inappropriate language on or around the courts.
- Children of primary school age should be accompanied by an adult.

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
