- Not use bad, inappropriate or racist language, including on social media or any digital platform
- Not bully, intimidate or harass anyone, including on social media or any digital platform
- Not smoke, drink alcohol or drugs of any kind on club premises or whilst representing the club at competitions or events
- Talk to the club Welfare Officer about any concerns or worries they have about themselves or others
