

Risk Assessment Policy

Blewbury Tennis Club will carry out a full annual risk assessment of the facility with a view of highlighting potential hazards and taking the appropriate action wherever necessary to ensure a safe and enjoyable environment.

If a member/user wishes to report a hazard or potential hazard, they should contact any member of the Committee.

Both maintenance and health & safety are standing agenda items for Committee meetings. Any issues are raised and the appropriate action taken; all details will be noted in the minutes.

The annual risk assessment includes the following areas:

- Is the area and surroundings safe and free from obstacles?
- Is the area fit and appropriate for activity?
- Is the equipment fit and sound for activity and suitable for age group/ability?
- Is the members register up-to-date with medical information and contact details?
- Are players appropriately attired for the activity?
- Do volunteers, coaches and members have access to information relating to health and safety?
- Are emergency procedures published and accessible to those with responsibility for sessions at the venue?

Playing Area

Check that the area and surroundings are safe and free from obstacles. Is the area fit and appropriate for activity?

Equipment

Check that it is fit and sound for activity and suitable for age group/ability. Is the equipment safe and appropriate for activity?

Members / Players

Please contact members @blewburytennis.co.uk if you would like a copy of the information held about you as a member of the club. Check that the members register is up-to-date with medical information and contact details. Ensure players are appropriately attired for the activity.

Safety Information

Ensure that volunteers and coaches have access to information relating to health and safety. Are emergency procedures published and accessible to those with responsibility for sessions? Does the place to play need to take any further action?
