14 May 1954 – Sodbury Tennis Club Formed at the Ridings with three tarmac courts with no lights and a basic wooden scout hut repurposed as the 'clubhouse'.

1980s

1983 - Flood lights for two courts

1988 - Courts resurfaced with porous tarmac

1990s

1991 – Cotswold Stone Pavilion built, opened by Christopher Reeve, actor.

1998 - Four courts resurfaced with acrylic artificial grass.

2010s

2011 – Kitchen refurbishment and start of Annual Club Charity initially funded by friday night burgers

2014 - Flood lights for Court four, opened by Steve Webb

2014 - Tiger Turf court surface laid

 $2018-\mbox{Clubhouse}$ extended and refurbished opened by Chloe Ball-Hopkins, Para-athlete

2019 – LED flood lights

2020s to today

2023 – New games area for juniors resurfaced with Tiger Turf, new sports equipment and practice wall mural installed.

1970s

Longest Standing Members

Dale Curtis and Steve Mackereth joined the club in 1971 and members for 53 years! Dale won the mens singles in the club tournament in every decade of his membership until 2020s.

Bristol and District League Winners

Throughout the 70s the Men's 1st team won their groups on 5 consecutive years taking the team from group 7 in 1970 to Group 3 by 1974.

Avon County Ladies Team Players

Julie Midgley 'Midge' and Liz Monaghan were the first ladies to represent Sodbury in the Avon County Team and also played in the National County Championships.

2000s

New Club Coaching Regime introduced in early 2000s.

Kathy Ryan was appointed coaching coordinator and along with many home grown and professionally qualified coaches, notably Steve Johnson, built a thriving junior club section.

A positive drive by the committee to encouraged ladies tennis meant STC fielded many league teams.
