I heartily welcome any suggestions for either social events or tennis competitions. I will visit other clubs and contact their respective secretaries in order to gain information to expand on what we already do.

I want to say a big thank you to the Committee members who work so hard. What I have learned is amongst the Committee we all have very different types of expertise, be it practical, in IT, finance, marketing or tennis playing and coaching and together I hope we can continue to make the club a success.
